## Nursery

Welcome to Nursery at Holy Name Catholic Primary school. Our nursery teacher is Mrs R Price-Patel and our Teaching Assistant is Mrs C Nokes.

### Homework Arrangements

Every **Friday** children will be given a '**Weekend News**' sheet. Your child will need to complete the sheet at home over the weekend. You will then need to take a picture of your child holding their sheet and upload this onto our "Evidence Me" app with a brief description of what they have been doing over the weekend. Watch this space for further information on how to do this!

Children will then be encouraged to talk to the adults and children in the Nursery about what you have uploaded onto the "Evidence Me" app.

Children will also be bringing home a '**Wow Petal**.' This is an opportunity for you to tell us about anything fantastic your child has been doing at home. This can be anything ranging from 'putting their shoes on independently,' 'sleeping in their own bed all night,' or 'being kind to their brother or sister.' The petals are then displayed on our "**Wow Petals Tree**" for everyone to see and share.

Every **Friday** your child will bring home a **reading book**. This is a general book from our Nursery library which the children will choose themselves. We encourage all parents/carers to explore and read the book with their child and return it to Nursery the **following Friday**.

Monday's are '**Movement Mondays**'. Could you please ensure that you send your child to school plain black or grey jogging bottoms, school P.E pumps and their normal Holy Name polo shirt and jumper.
