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Mr Stink Character Description







Fossilisation Process



As erosion and weathering takes place, eventually the fossils become exposed.

Over a long period of time the sea will recede in certain places.

Over time more layers of rock cover it and by this time the only thing to remain of the animal would be its bones (except in the case of mould fossils where the bones would also be decayed).

An animal or creature dies and ends up in the sea. It gets covered by a layer of rock.

Over thousands of years the mould fossil might become a cast fossil with sediment entering the mould. In the case of replacement fossils, the original bone matter changes to mineral matter but this does not affect the shape of the bones.



Soft and Chewy Cookies



Ingredients

110g butter

110g soft brown sugar

100g white sugar

1 egg

200g plain flour

 $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp baking powder

1 tsp vanilla extract

75g chocolate chips, raisins or mini marshmallows

Equipment

mixing bowl

whisk

dessert spoon

baking paper

baking tray

Method

- 1. Set the oven to 160°C.
- 2. Beat the butter and sugar together until creamy.
- 3. Beat in the egg and the vanilla.
- 4. Stir in the flour and baking powder and mix into a dough.
- 5. Fold in the chocolate chips, raisins or marshmallows.
- 6. Place the baking paper on to the baking tray.
- 7. Using the dessert spoon, spoon the cookie mixture on to the baking paper. Space the cookies out over the tray as they will spread in the oven.
- 8. Bake the cookies in the oven for about 15-20 minutes.
