## **English**

Sandwell secondary schools are asking for you to complete the following writing task:

# Year 6 English task:

Imagine you have discovered a Time Machine that could take you forwards and backwards in time — from the Ancient Egyptians, to Medieval England. Write a description of the world you see when you step out of the machine — where in time did you go?

Using your ideas from last Friday (Task 5) can you write about your time traveller adventure? Aim to write about at least three areas in time.

#### You should aim to include:

- At least three time era that you travelled to.
- Around 5 paragraphs (one to introduce your travelling journey, three for each time era that you end
  up in and describe and a concluding paragraph to summarise your time travel)
- Use your best descriptive phrases (see below), sentence openers and a wide range of punctuation!
- Aim to complete at least an a4 page you might like to complete it on Microsoft word (font size 12) first and then copy it onto the link below.
- Before you send it, read over it first to check it makes sense.

**Open a word document**, write your first name and last name and type away. When you have finished, save the work, with your name on and <u>upload it to here</u> so I can download it. I will then send this to your new school.
