More extra-curricular opportunities 	<p>Sports clubs have been running for the last two years (and more) – gymnastics, multi-skills, dance etc. are just a few!</p> <p>Other curricular clubs have been provided by staff and outside agencies, such as: art club, cookery club, choir club, recorder club, film club, science club.</p> <p>We will continue to liaise with other providers to extend the range of extra-curricular clubs that we are able to offer.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The area around nursery looks a bit scruffy, it's a tight squeeze to access due to all the toys. 	<p>Plans are underway to develop the nursery playground – fencing has been put up to make the access clearer.</p> <p>Plans to jet wash the outdoor shelter to gain more light are underway!</p>

Improvements to the school playground – grass/AstroTurf Trees and grass sometimes look overgrown. 	<p>We are working closely with the school council to develop the playground with clear rules and activity sections – watch this space!</p> <p>Grass and astro turf has been looked into – unfortunately it is extremely pricy!</p> <p>Trees and grass are cut regularly across the school year.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> More workshops as the ones attended have been helpful. 	<p>Workshops will continue – we welcome your support.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> More notice of trips/events – improved communication with parents 	<p>We will ensure that you receive at least three weeks' notice.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The amount of homework needs to be reduced. 	<p>90% of parents felt that homework was appropriate.</p> <p>We are looking into setting homework on MyMaths soon.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> More swimming lessons. 	<p>Children in Y6 currently have swimming lessons this will be extended to other classes across the year. We have to provide at least three members of staff everytime we take a class swimming which can be difficult to accommodate as we only have a small team of staff.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Aprons to be used in art lessons 	<p>Aprons have been purchased.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Improved discipline Stricter enforcement of playground rules 	<p>'Good to be Green' has been implemented and closer supervision of behaviour is taking place.</p> <p>Both Mr Neenan and Mrs Chapman supervise the playground at lunchtime to monitor behaviour.</p>
