Other comments:	Our response:
A small number of parents raised concerns about their child's homework.	All teaching staff are familiar with our school's homework policy (which is available to view on our school website). Please check this as a starting point if you have a concern. We are open to trialling different arrangements for homework such as making it accessible online and arranging a lunchtime club for any pupils who cannot access a computer at home. Please approach your child's class teacher directly if you have any concerns about homework. If the matter is unresolved after this then please arrange to speak to Mrs Chapman or Mr Neenan.
It would be nice to receive positive feedback at the end of the day and have consistent use of praise.	We aim to provide pupils with positive feedback daily through verbal conversations and marking. We will feedback to parents as much as is practically possible. With the use of the 'Good to be Green' system we aim for consistency with praise through the use of green being good and privilege cards for exceptional behaviours. Furthermore, pupils are awarded in assembly each week and we communicate through mid-year and end-of-year reports along with parents' evening.
Sometimes at showcases parents sit with their own child and pupils without parents can find it upsetting.	We love to invite you in so that the children can showcase their talents. We will be reviewing how parent showcases have been facilitated to date and consider ways we could change this.
More clubs should be available.	We offer many clubs, such as: cookery club, Y5 & 6 rewards club, arts and crafts club, choir club, sports club etc. We have clubs running on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. We will continue to liaise with outside providers to try to extend our extra-curricular provision.
We would like more notice for events.	We aim to give at least three weeks' notice prior to any events taking place. All teaching staff are regularly reminded to arrange class trips well in advance.
It would be useful to be able to pay online for things.	We have looked into this and at the moment it is not financially viable for school.
It would be great to have a workshop for SATs preparation in Y2 & Y6.	We are in the process of scheduling dates for these.
