What is the PTA

Holy Name PTA is a charity that seeks to raise funds to improve the school for our children. All families of pupils at our school are members of the PTA. The PTA runs regular fundraising and social events for the whole school community. The PTA Committee are responsible for managing the charity, and are elected each year at the AGM. Our fundraising efforts help to enhance the education and experience of all the children at the school and will continue to do so with your support.

What can you do?

All parents and members of the school community are encouraged to get involved, even if they only have a small amount of time available. There are lots of ways you can help and support your child through the PTA:

Offering to help at events such as Crafty Christmas or the Summer Fete. This can be helping set up, manning a stall, helping clear up after, selling raffle tickets, etc.

Join our committee where you can have a direct impact on what we do, how we do it and where the funds we raise go. We meet about 8 times per school year at the parish centre and the meetings generally only last half an hour.

You can help by letting us know if you have any contacts or skills we could use, everything is potentially valuable to us. Do you work for a bank or building society who can give match funding for example?

You can share any fundraising ideas you may have.

If you would like to be more involved you can volunteer to be a Class Representative or Committee Member. We are a friendly bunch and everyone is welcome.
