MATHS	 Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday Below you find a range of maths worksheets to try with your child all connected to "The Hungry Caterpillar." Print them off and have a go at as many as you can. Thursday and Friday Matching numeral to quantity. On separate pieces of paper write the numbers 1-10. Gather a range of object from around your home. It could be Lego, crayons, spoons, beads etc. Ask your child to put the correct number of objects onto the correct number. For example; 3 pieces of Lego onto the number 3. Start with numbers 1-5 and then attempt numbers 6-10. Challenge; Ask your child "If we put 1 more piece of Lego on how many would we have?" 	Don't forget to take a picture and tell us all about how your child does on the "Evidence me" app!
TOPIC	After reading the story of "The Hungry Caterpillar" with your child, have a discussion about food! Ask your child; "What foods did the Hungry Caterpillar eat?" "What foods did the Hungry Caterpillar eat?" "Where all of the foods healthy foods?" "Which foods were healthy/unhealthy?" Now ask your child what is their favourite food? Talk about if it is a healthy or unhealthy food. Get your child to draw a picture of their favourite food. You could try some of the different fruits mentioned in the story. Ask your child which one is their favourite? They could try some apples, pears, strawberries, oranges, plums or watermelon. They could also try some other fruits. Ask your child what other fruits might "The Very Hungry Caterpillar" like to eat?	Don't forget to take a picture and tell us all about how your child does on the "Evidence me" app!




The Very Hungry Caterpillar Numbers and Counting Sheet

Can you draw a line from the number to the correct amount of fruit?




The Very Hungry Caterpillar Counting Sheet
