


There are 5 ladybirds on the leaf. Can you find some more ladybirds hidden around the page? How many are there altogether?






Jack's beanstalk is 8cm tall. It grows 2cm taller. How tall is Jack's beanstalk?

### **How to Get Your Child Thinking**


- Can you explain how you knew which was one more than your chosen number?

- Can you put that number in your head and count on?





# **Bouncy Egg**

Science Experiment

### Method

- 1. Place the boiled egg in the bowl.
- If you would like the finished egg to be coloured, add a few drops of food colouring to the vinegar.
- Cover the boiled egg with vinegar and cover the bowl with cling film.
- 4. Leave for 3-5 days.
- After 3 days, remove the egg from the bowl and rinse the shell off the egg under a gently running tap.

### You will need:

One boiled egg

White vinegar

Food colouring (optional)

Bowl

Cling film
